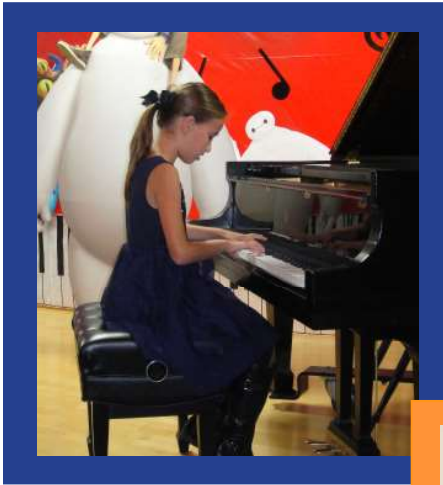


Camila Baranda Student Teacher
